

ORDINANCE NO. #326

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 238 OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING CITY, BY AMENDING SECTION 2, SUBSECTION 3, TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON WHO SHALL ALLOW A DOG TO BARK FOR AN UNREASONABLE LENGTH OF TIME SHALL BE GUILTY OF DISTURBING THE PEACE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Spring City and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 238 of the Borough of Spring City, Section 2, Subsection 3, is amended to read as follows:

Any person who shall disturb or annoy the peaceable residents, inhabitants or travelers in the Borough by making any unseemly noise, such as sounding any siren, or using any other noisemaker, or wilfully causing the screeching or squealing of tires of any vehicle, or in the use of fireworks, or in the use of any amplification system, either stationary or movable in nature, or otherwise to make any undue or unseemly noise; or who shall allow a dog to bark for an unreasonable length of time shall be guilty of disturbing the peace; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, this paragraph shall not be held to apply to any public event, parade, sound truck announcement or celebration for which a permit has been issued by the Borough, or to the sounding of bells or sirens operated by the various fire departments, police officers and ambulance drivers operating on official business within the Borough and in performance of their duties.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
